A passport and visa are required for travel to Sierra Leone. Visitors to Sierra Leone are required to show their International Certificates of Vaccination (yellow card) upon arrival at the airport with a record of vaccination against yellow fever

PLEASE NOTE THAT WHEN BOOKING YOUR RETURN FLIGHT FROM JFK YOU MUST BOOK IT FOR A LATER FLIGHT THAT DAY AS YOU WILL BE ARRIVING AT 12:55 PM IN THE AFTERNOON AND YOU NEED TO BE FLEXIBLE IN CASE THERE ARE DELAYS OR ANYTHING UNFORSEEN HAPPENS. THIS WILL AVOID YOU MISSING YOUR CONNECTION.

Effective **Monday 14th, July 2014**, all **CONSULAR PAYMENTS** must be made by **MONEY ORDER** or **BANK CHEQUES** made payable to the Embassy of Sierra Leone. Transactions will include and not limited to payments for Visas (both normal and expedited) payments for Emergency Traveling Certificates, Authentication of Documents etc.

To obtain a Sierra Leone visa, you must do the following:

- Submit a completed visa application form with one recent passport size photograph (less than six months old.)
- A passport valid at least one year before the date of expiration. Passport must contain sufficient blank visa pages.
- Copy of travel itinerary or round trip ticket should be produced. In some instances, the consular office will invite applicants for interview.
- For applicants that are minors, both parents must sign the form, the child's birth certificate attached and a notary public must notarize the form.

- If applicant is mailing the passport, an **express prepaid self-addressed envelope** should be enclosed. For applicants outside of the US are strongly advise to send a return **UPS prepaid** self-addressed envelope with tracking number. Cash is not accepted.
- A valid and up-to-date international certificate of vaccination (yellow fever).
- Effective **Monday 14th, July 2014**, all **CONSULAR PAYMENTS** must be made by **MONEY ORDER or CASHIERS CHECK** made payable to the Embassy of Sierra Leone. Transactions will include and not limited to payments for Visas both normal and expedited payments for Emergency Travelling Certificates, Authentication of Documents etc.
- **Processing time:** Between three to five business days
- **Consular hours:** 10:00am to 3:00pm (Mondays thru Fridays)
- **Lunch hour:** 1PM to 2PM
- **Applicants who wish to receive their Visa the same day, have to pay an expedited fee of US\$ 50.00 and should submit their application latest 12 p.m. to be collected between the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

Note: Only Prepaid **United States Postal express mail or priority express** next day delivery is accepted and **for applicants outside of the United States use "Prepaid UPS Return Envelope" only.**
